



THE ALCHEMY OF BLUE...

Coledale-based artist, Lizzie Buckmaster Dove, has been walking the same beach route daily for five years. As she walks, she fossicks and collects fragments of the Coledale sea pool that have broken away and washed onto the beach. These little pieces, together with pieces salvaged during the pool's renovation, have been carefully and meticulously arranged on the rock platforms to construct Pool, The Alchemy of Blue, an installation referencing the circle of the moon and the pool's tidal nature.

"It isn't about ruin but about transformation. Abstract concepts are rendered in a concrete material, weight becomes light, concrete appears to float, the impossible becomes the possible and the intimacy of individual pieces of concrete seem to belie the immensity of the pool, the rock platform, the stretching sea and the vast sky," she says.

On the full moon of 25 May, Lizzie will construct another in situ rock creation and she welcomes assistants. If you would like to take part, bring your gloves and boots to the rock platform beside the Coledale Pool.
